

## Diploma Exam Information – August 2020

- All exams will be held in the large gym at Salisbury Composite High School (20 Festival Way).
- Please maintain physical distancing when lining up outside and in the designated waiting areas in the school while waiting for entrance to the gym.
- Students will enter the doors from the BACK parking lot, next to the gym. Access is from Sherwood Dr.
- Please arrive at 8:15. For Biology 30, Please arrive at 12:15.
- The writing centre is a quiet zone; please refrain from all talking when you enter the gym.
- The use of washrooms is limited to escorted visits.
- You must remain in the gym for the first hour of the exam.
- Students arriving one hour after the exam has started will NOT be able to write the exam.
- Please leave the writing center promptly after finishing your exam.

### ITEMS TO BRING

**Provincial Covid-19 Screening Questionnaire** You MUST have answered “No” to all of the questions to enter the school.

**Identification** You MUST present photo ID to enter the exam (ex. Driver’s license, passport, school ID)

#### Items for the exam:

**For all exams:** HB pencil, sharpener, pen, eraser, highlighters.

**For English Part A:** print dictionary, thesaurus and approved writer’s handbook\*, all completely free of notes.

**For Social Part A:** authorized print dictionary and thesaurus that does **not** contain appendices that include Social Studies content, and approved writer’s handbook\*, all completely free of notes.

**For Math, Bio, Chemistry and Physics:** approved, cleared calculator\* and extra batteries; protractor; ruler.

**Food and snacks:** if needed. Bring only CLEAR water bottles or sealed drink containers (ex. juice box). Small snacks in sealed or clear packaging are appropriate (ex. Fruit, granola bars). No sharing of food or materials is permitted.

**Additional items to bring:** If needed, you may bring non-electronic earplugs (the small sponge style that fit in the ear) and Kleenex (in clear packaging or separate sheets). Students are not required to but are encouraged to bring a mask and hand sanitizer.

### ITEMS NOT PERMITTED

English and Social students must ensure that their dictionary, thesaurus and handbook are completely free of notes.

Please bring only the permitted items. We will not be able to store any items.

Do NOT bring backpacks, jackets, hats, purses, cell phones, headphones, and other electronics. They are not permitted in the writing space.

**Cell phones, electronic watches and other electronic devices are not allowed.**
